English teacher as a foreign language

Presentation of the structure: Happy Chandara is a school for young underprivileged girls, comprised of one primary school, one middle school and one high school. The students are provided with a high quality education in foreign languages as well as lessons aimed at opening them up to the world around them, in addition to the Khmer state school curriculum. You will play a key role in this country under reconstruction, which suffered greatly during the Khmer Rouge regime. The school hosts about 1.300 students and the classes are comprised of 20 to 30 students.

Location: Cambodia, Prek Thmey, at 13km of Phnom Penh.

- Prepare monthly and quarterly assessments and fill out the academic transcripts of the school.

- Set up pedagogical activities in the classroom and outdoors, as well as taking part in external events.
- Sign up for a cultural program and generate our students' creativity and imagination.
